

GRINDING DISC'S

I also have a great price on all of my grinding discs. The ones I carry are made by Mercer Abrasive. Mercer has a patent on the way they make their discs. There are a full 5 layers instead of 3 layers of resinated fiberglass compressed down to 1/4 inch thickness. So they aren't any thicker but they're higher in density, giving a 2 to 1 life over standard wheels. Our most common size sold is the 4 1/2 inch and anyone working with me on a small box of the wheels I can throw in a Hitachi 4 1/2" angle grinder with a 9 amp motor for free! What size do you use? (Refer to table for price. As a reference always add 2\$ for retail price.) On the 4 1/2 inch discs the normally retail for \$5.39 a disc but if you work with me on a small box i'll throw in the free angle grinder for just \$3.39 a disc delivered. That's a good price right!

There are just 100 wheels in a small box for customer to receive the grinder.
